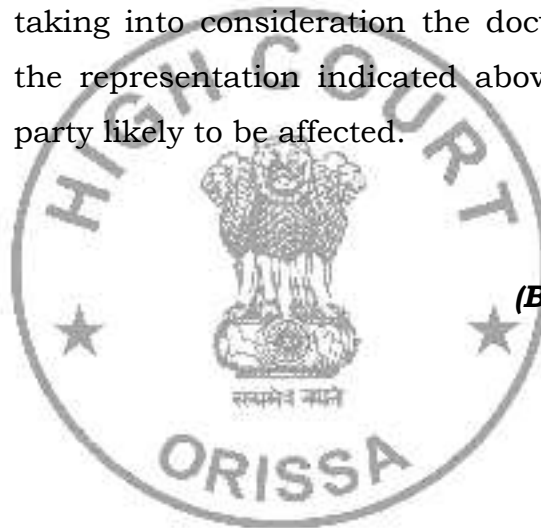

1. Heard learned counsels appearing for the parties.

For the subsequent development taking place during pendency of these writ petitions, there is bypassing of relief involving both the writ petitions and the relief is now restricted to the extent in the matter of disposal of a representation of the petitioner dated 03.08.2021, appears to be pending before the Senior Divisional Retail Manager,
