2. Heard Mr. S.N. Nayak, learned Additional Standing Counsel appearing for the State-Petitioners and Mr. B.B. Mohanty, learned Counsel for Opposite Party No.1.

3. Mr. S.N. Nayak, learned Additional Standing Counsel appearing for the State-Petitioners, on instructions, contended that the Disciplinary Proceeding initiated against Opposite Party No.1 has been concluded and the matter is placed to the Government for approval.
