02. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
2. The Petitioner having been implicated in connection with Dharmasala P.S. Case No.216 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No.1083 of 2021 pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C., Chandikhole running for the alleged commission of offence under section-379/34 of the IPC read with Section-21 of the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act & Section-3/4//5 of the Explosive Substances Act has filed this application under Section-438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in the above mentioned case.
3. Heard learned Counsel for the Petitioner and learned Counsel for the State.
