01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offences under Sections 341/323/294/307/379/506/34, I.P.C.
4. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, though I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioners surrender before the learned S.D.J.M., Jharsuguda in C.T. Case No.2587 of 2021 corresponding to Rengali P.S. Case No.153 of 2021 within a period of three weeks from today, the Petitioners shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, but subject to verification of the injury

report. In the event it is found that the injuries are grievous in nature, then this bail order shall not be given effect to.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
6. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
