1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail.
4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the entire allegation is against the husband. So far as the present Petitioners are concerned, Petitioner No.1 is the father-in-law and Petitioner No.2 is the elder sister-in-law.
5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners. However, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners surrender before the learned S.D.J.M., Jagatsinghpur in G.R.Case No.737 of 2022 arising out of Jagatsinghpur P.S.Case No.319 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and move for bail, they shall be released on bail on

such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate with further conditions that they shall not torture, humiliate and harass the informant and his family members in any manner whatsoever and shall cooperate with the cooperate with the investigation and shall appear before the I.O. as and when required for the purpose of investigation. Violation of conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

6. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
7. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules.
