01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offences punishable under Sections 143/147/148/294/324/325/307/506/149, I.P.C.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioners does not press this application for bail so far as Petitioner No.2 – Prabash Chandra Kheti @ Prabhas is concerned. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is dismissed as not pressed so far as Petitioner no.2 is concerned.
5. So far as Petitioner No.1 – Sukanta Kheti is concerned, considering the nature of allegation, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to Petitioner No.1, however it is observed that, in the event Petitioner

No.1 surrenders before the learned J.M.F.C., Kantamal in C.T. Case No.167 of 2022 corresponding to Manamunda P.S. Case No.107 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

6. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
