1. Considering that an appeal is preferable against the impugned order under Section 18(5)(b) of the Orissa Entry Tax Act, 1999 (OET Act), the Appellant is permitted to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to file such appeal in accordance with law.
 2. If such appeal is filed not later than 1st February, 2023 accompanied by an application for condonation of delay explaining the delay on account of the pendency of the present appeal, it will be considered by the Appellate Authority in accordance with law.
 3. Accordingly, the appeal is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

4. The originals be returned to the Appellant subject to it being substituted by attested photocopies thereof. The Court clarifies that it has not expressed any view in the matter.
