 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.

 3. This is an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. and the offences alleged are under Sections 147/148/ /302/460/506/120-B/ 149 of the I.P.C., Section 25/27 of the Arms Act and Sections 16/17/18/20/22 of the UAP Act and Section 17 of the Crl. Amendment Act.
