 1. Heard Mr. D.K. Sahoo, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. D.K. Mohanty, learned Additional Standing Counsel.
 2. At the outset, on the oral prayer, Mr. Sahoo is permitted to properly describe opposite party no.1 in the cause title in Court today.
 3. According to Mr. Sahoo, the petitioner, who happens to be the informant in Tantiapal Marine P.S. Case No.54 dated 19.05.2022 registered for commission of offences under Sections 341/323/294/420/467/471/120-B/34, I.P.C. is aggrieved by the manner in which investigation is going on in connection with above noted case. During course of hearing, he submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to approach the Superintendent of Police, Kendrapara (opposite party no.3) for redressal of her grievances.
 4. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court grants liberty to the petitioner to approach the Superintendent Police, Kendrapara (opposite party no.3) by

filing a grievance petition along with a certified copy of this order through Registered Post within a period of two weeks. In the event such grievance petition is received by opposite party no.3, he/she is directed to take a decision on the same in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the said petition and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

5. The CRLMP is accordingly disposed of.

6. Issue urgent certified copy of this order on proper application.
