03. 1. This matter is taken up hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
2. The Petitioners having been implicated in connection with Khurda P.S. Case No.270 of 2020 corresponding to G.R. Case No.909 of 2020 registered for alleged commission of offence under Section-341/323/325/427/294/387/506/34 of the IPC, pending on the file of learned S.D.J.M., Athagarh have filed this application under section-438 of the Cr.P.C. for their grant of anticipatory bail in the above mentioned case.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

Considering the submissions and on going through the materials on record as also other surrounding circumstances; while being not inclined to grant of anticipatory bail to the Petitioners, this application is disposed of with the observation that when the occasion would so arise before the learned Court in seisin of the case for consideration of the prayer for regular
