1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the allegations against the Petitioner is totally false and omnibus in nature. The Petitioner is no way connected in the alleged crime and has been falsely entangled in this case.
5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M., Sambalpur in G.R.Case No.2369 of 2022 arising out of Mahila

P.S.Case No.53 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and moves for bail, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate with further condition that the Petitioner shall not harass and threaten the victim and her family members.

6. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
