01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.520 of 2022, arising out of Baleswar Sadar P.S. Case No.190 of 2022 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C.(R), Baleswar for commission of offence punishable under Sections 294/307/427/506/34, I.P.C.
5. It is submitted learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely implicated in the case.
6. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioner

surrender before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today in the aforesaid case, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper with further conditions that petitioner shall not harass, torture, threaten or terrorize the informant and his/her family members in any manner whatsoever and he shall cooperate with the Investigating Officer as when required for the purpose of investigation.

Violation of any of the terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

7. It is open for the court in seisin over the matter to impose other conditions as may be deemed just and proper.

8. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
