01. 1. This writ petition involves the following prayer:-

“It is, therefore, humbly prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to direct the O.P. No. 3 & 4 to take appropriate steps to the grievance made by the petitioners under Annexure-3 within a stipulated period.

And pass such other order(s)/direction(s) as this Hon’ble Court deem fit and proper.”

Considering the innocuous prayer made in this writ petition and as a representation at the instance of the Petitioner on the selfsame issue is still pending before the Collector, Nayagarh, this Court without expressing any opinion on the claim of the Petitioner, directs the Collector, Nayagarh to consider the representation at the instance of the Petitioner vide Annexure-4 and take a lawful decision
