1. Learned counsel appearing for Opposite Party No.6 states that he has no instructions. Nobody is appearing to oppose the prayer in the present petition that the Petitioner should be permitted to intervene in the proceedings in CMC No.940 of 2014 pending in the file of the A.D.C.P.-cum-Executive Magistrate, Bhubaneswar which is stayed by this Court on 18th May, 2016.
