01. 1. Considering that there is a remedy of appeal against the assessment order, the Court is not inclined to interfere either with the assessment order or the consequential demand notice at this stage.
2. Permitting the Petitioner to avail the statutory remedy of appeal in accordance with law, the petition is disposed of. If the appeal is filed not later than 26th September, 2022 along with an application for condonation of delay then the Appellate Authority will consider the question of delay taking into account the period during which the present petition was pending in this Court.
