1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. In the course of hearing of the CRLMC, Mr. R. Achary, learned counsel for the Petitioner while praying to dispose of the CRLMC submits that the criminal case may be disposed of in a time bound manner. Learned counsel for the State is present and raises no objection to such prayer made for the Petitioner.
