- 3.** The aforesaid four writ petitions have been filed, primarily challenging the permission, granted by the Excise Authorities, to shift the location of IMFL “OFF”

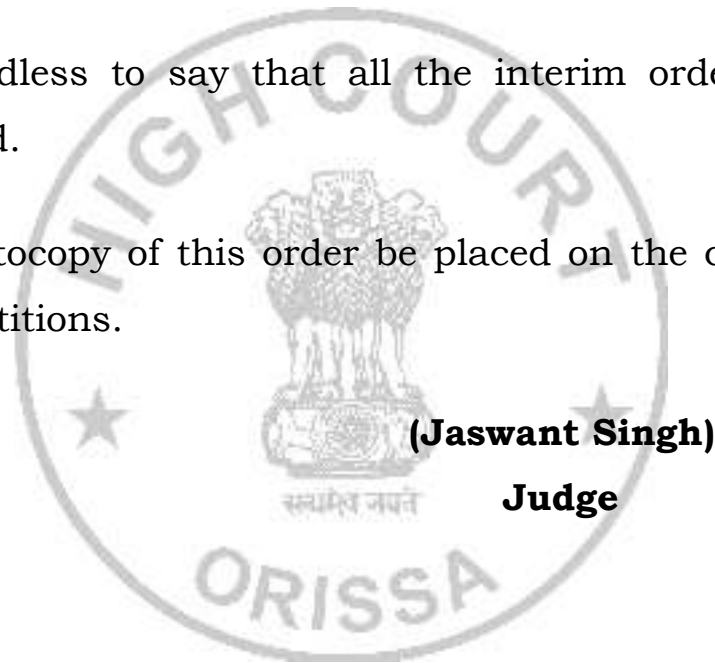
Shop/country spirit shop from the original notified locations to another locations.
