1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.

3. The Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“(i) Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case it is therefore, prayed that this Hon’ble Court may kindly issue writ in the nature of mandamus or any other writ application by direct to the Opposite Parties to release the Pensionary benefit as well as the Family Pension in favour of the petitioner being the widow daughter, after the death of the father of the petitioner, who was getting family pension as per the Govt. of Odisha Pension Rule, as deemed just and proper”.

4. He further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed an appeal on 19.01.2022 under Annexure-7 to the Writ Petition before the opposite party No.2 but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he

prays that a direction be issued to opposite party no.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
