- 1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard Mr. K.C.Sahu, learned counsel for the Petitioners.
- 3.** The petitioners have filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to regularize their services as Driver as they have all completed more than 6 years of service.
- 4.** Mr. Sahu, learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the case of the petitioners have been recommended by the opposite party no.2 for regularization as per Annexures-11 & 12. Therefore, a direction may be given to the opposite party no.1 to pass an order with regard to regularization of the service of the petitioners by holding HPC.
- 5.** In view of the above, this writ petition stands disposed of directing the Principal Secretary, Health & Family Welfare Department, Odisha-opposite party no.1 to take a decision with regard to the regularization of the petitioners, taking into consideration the recommendation as per Annexures-11 & 12, by holding the HPC as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of communication of the certified/authenticated copy of the order.
