2. Heard Mr. S.P. Mohanty, learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner and Mr. S. Nayak, learned Addl. Standing Counsel appearing for the State-Opposite Parties.

3. The Petitioner has filed this Writ Petition seeking to quash the demand notice dated 04.07.2022 under Annexure-1.
