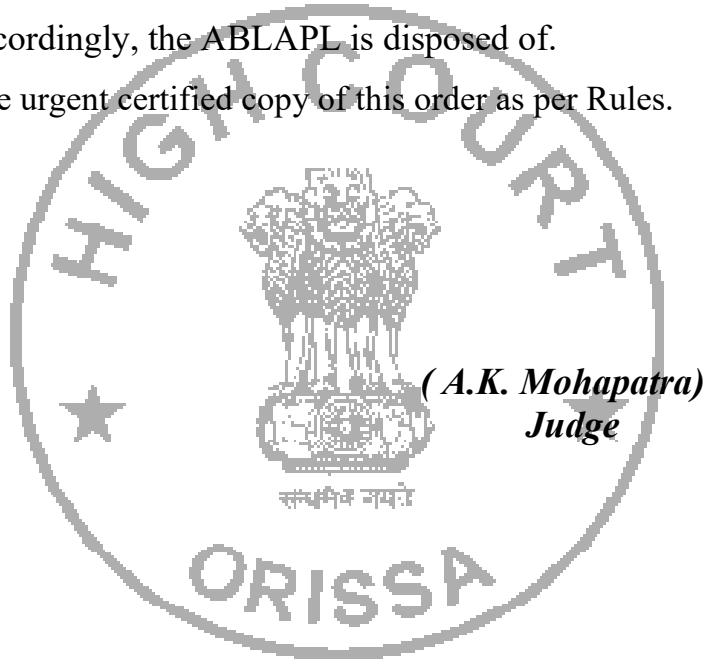

1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Additional Government Advocate. Perused the records.
 3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail.
 4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the Petitioner is the registered owner of the car bearing Regd.No.OD-02-BN-9164, which was seized by the Police in connection with the case. He also submits that the Petitioner is the close friend of co-accused Aswini Kumar Bagarty, who had taken his car for some for his personal use, but they have committed such type of crime without the knowledge of the Petitioner.

5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M., Rairakhol in G.R.Case No.397 of 2022 arising out of Charmal P.S.Case No.90 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and moves for bail, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate and subject to verification of criminal antecedent of similar nature against the Petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
