1. This matter is taken up hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
 2. The Petitioner having been implicated in Keonjhar Town P.S. Case No.159 of 2020 corresponding to Special Case No.58 of 2020 registered for alleged commission of offence under Section-367(3)/506 of the IPC read with section-6 of the POCSO Act, pending on the file of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Keonjhar has filed this application under section-438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in the above mentioned case.
 3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
