01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail.
4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the entire allegation leveled against the Petitioner is omnibus in nature. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that none of the independent witnesses as well as interested witnesses whispered a single word against the Petitioner so far as the present case is concerned.
5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M., Bhadrak

in 2(C) C.C.Case No.390 of 2022 arising out of R.P.F.Bhadrak P.S.Case No.17 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and moves for bail, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate and subject to verification of criminal antecedents of similar nature against the Petitioner.

6. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
