1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is an accused in U.D. Case No.7^B of 2022-23 converted to O.R. Case No.13^B of 2022-23, on the files of J.M.F.C. Badamba, corresponding to 2(b)CC No.4 of 2022, under Sections 9 & 52 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act punishable under Section 51 of the said Act and is in custody since 09.07.2022.
4. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Athagarh, by order dated 15.07.2022 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.
5. Perused the rejection order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused one Narendra Dehury has been released on bail by this Court by order dated 21.07.2022 in BLAPL No.6023 of 2022.

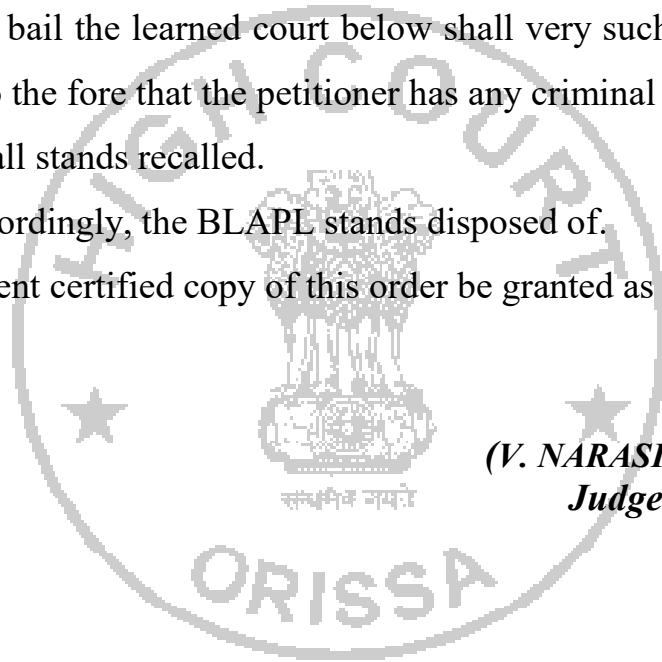
