- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.
3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer:-

“Therefore, it is humbly prayed that, this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to direct the opp. Parties more specially opp. Party no. 3 & 4 to allow the benefits under 2nd Revised Assured Carrier Progression Scheme (RACP) under Annexure-2 in favour of the Petitioner immediately from the date of notification vide notification no. 9769 dd.08.06.2015 with all arrear dues.

Or, any other order/orders, direction/direction may be passed by this Hon’ble Court in favour of the Petitioner.

And for this act of kindness the Petitioners as in duty bound shall ever pray.”

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further submits that through highlighting her grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation at Annexure-5 to the Writ Petition before the O.P. No.3, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays that a direction be issued to Opposite Party No.3 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.3 to take a decision on the above noted petition taking into account Annexure-2 within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the Petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
