1. This writ petition involves the following prayer:-

“The petitioner therefore humbly prayed that, this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to allow the Writ application, issue Rule NISI calling upon the Opp. parties to show cause, as to why a joint demarcation of the private property of the petitioner shall not be carried out for the greater interest of justice, in the facts and circumstances of the case.

And if the opp. parties fail to show-cause or show insufficient cause to make the rule absolute by issuing an appropriate writ(s)/ order(s) / direction (s) as this Hon’ble Court deems just and proper according to the facts and circumstances of the present case.”
