2. The petitioner is an accused in C.T. Case No.03 of 2019, pending on the file of learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Judge Special Court Deogarh, for commission of alleged offences under Section 376(2)(n)/363/366/294/506/34 of IPC read with Section 6 of the POCSO Act read with section 3(1)(r)/3(2)(v)(va) of SC & S.T. (PoA) Act and is in custody since 21.04.2022.
3. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Spl. Judge, Deogarh by order dated 13.05.2022 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.
