07. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
2. The Petitioners having been implicated in connection with Biramitrapur P.S. Case No.128 of 2020 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1340 of 2020 for alleged commission of offence under section- 341/294/323/364-A/386/395/376(2)(n)/120-B of the IPC, pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C., Biramitrapur have filed this application under section-438 of the Cr.P.C. for their grant of anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest in the above mentioned case.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State as well as learned Counsel for the Informant.
4. Considering the submissions made and on going through the materials on record further keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offences and its manner of commission as also the role assigned to the Petitioners therein as those emanate from the

materials on record as well as other surrounding circumstances; while being not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners, this application is disposed of with the observation that when the occasion would so arise before the learned Court in seisin of the case for consideration of the prayer for grant of regular bail of the Petitioners, same shall be decided on its own merit and disposed of early in accordance with law.
