1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is an accused in Special (POCSO) Case No.62 of 2022, on the files of learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Court under POCSO Act, Angul, arising out of Banarpal P.S. Case No.210 of 2022, under Sections 363/366/376(2)(n) of IPC read with Section 6(1) of the POCSO Act and is in custody since 22.06.2022.
4. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned A.D.J.-cum-Special Court, under POCSO Act, Angul, by order dated 28.06.2022 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.
5. Taking into account the tenor of the 164 Cr.P.C. statement placed by the learned counsel for the State and keeping in view the

charge sheet has already been filed, this Court directs the petitioner to be released on bail on such terms to be fixed by the learned Court in seisin over the matter.
