1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
 3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail.
 4. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.1951 of 2022, arising out of Jharsuguda Sadar P.S. Case No.166 of 2022 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Jharsuguda for commission of offence punishable under Sections 394, I.P.C.
 5. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioner surrenders before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today in the aforesaid case, the petitioner shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be

deemed just and proper.

6. Further, it is directed that the petitioner shall given an undertaking before the learned court below that while releasing on bail, the petitioner will not involve in similar nature of offences failing which this order shall automatically revoked.

Violation of any of the terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
