01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners as well as learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offences punishable under Sections 498-A/294/323/506/307/34, I.P.C. and Section 4 of D.P. Act, 1961.
4. Considering the seriousness and gravity of the offence as alleged and the facts of the case, although this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioners surrender and apply for bail before the learned S.D.J.M., Kendrapara in G.R. Case No.1326 of 2022 corresponding to Kendrapara Sadar P.S. Case No.283 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, the Petitioners shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may

deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, but subject to condition that the Petitioners shall not threaten, terrorise, harass or ill-treat the Informant or her family members in any manner whatsoever. Violation of any of the conditions shall entail cancellation of bail of the Petitioners.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
6. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
