01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 3(1)(a)(b)(c) and 14 of the Orissa Kendu Leaves (Control of Trade) Act, and Rules 4, 14 and 21 of Orissa Timber Transit Rules and Section 56 of Orissa Forest Act.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the principal accused Md. Rizwan has been arrested and released on bail by this Court. He further submits that there is no similar nature of criminal antecedents against the present Petitioner.
5. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of the offence and facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory

bail to the Petitioner, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M., Rairakhol in 2(b)CC Case No.19 of 2022 arising out of Offence Report No.37(C) of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today, the Petitioner shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

6. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
