1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is an accused in connection with G.R. Case No.76 of 2022, arising out of Aul P.S.Case No. 37 of 2022, pending on the file of learned JMFC, Aulu for the alleged offence under Sections 294/420/406/506 of the I.P.C.
4. Being aggrieved by the rejection of her application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned Sessions Judge, Kendrapara(I/C) by order dated 28.07.2022, the present BLAPL has been filed.
5. Perused the Case Diary.
6. It is stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that it is a case of false implication and in fact, at the instance of the

petitioner Aul P.S. Case No. 370 of 2021 has been registered against the informant of the case at hand.

7. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

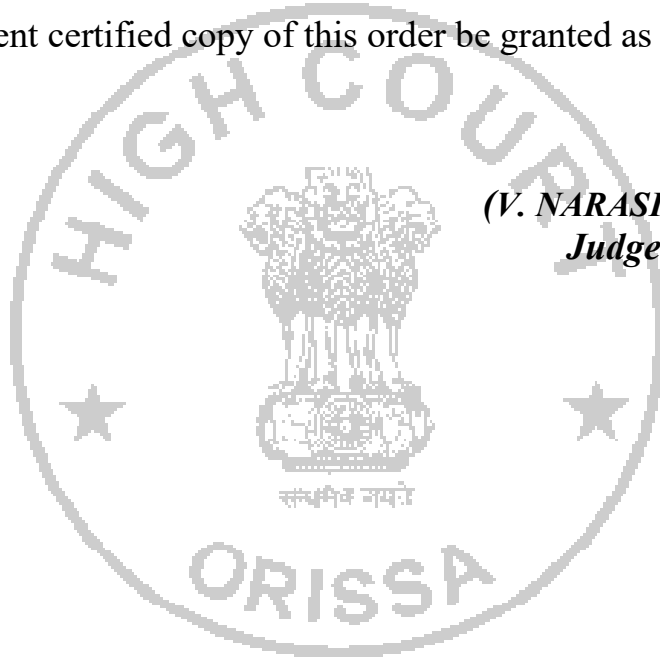
8. The F.I.R. in Aul P.S. Case No. 370 of 2021 in which the present informant is an accused is taken on record.
