3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to issue appointment order in his favour against any Class-III/IV post under the Rehabilitation Assistance Rules, 1990 in view of judgment *Malaya Nanda Sethy v. State of Odisha*, 2022(II) OLR (SC)
