01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Informant enters appearance through Mr.Sarada Prasad Dash, and his associates in Court today and files Vakalatnama. The same is accepted and be kept on record.
3. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
4. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail.
5. The petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.1267 of 2022, arising out of Bari Ramachandrapur P.S. Case No.157 of 2022 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Jajpur for commission of offence punishable under Sections 498-a/294/323/506/34, I.P.C. read with Section 4 of the D.P. Act.
6. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioner

surrenders before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today in the aforesaid case, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper with further conditions that petitioner shall not default in attendance of the court during trial on each date of posting and shall not harass, torture, threaten or terrorize the informant and his/her family members in any manner whatsoever while on bail.

Violation of any of the terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

8. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
