1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).

2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.

3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner for anticipatory bail.

4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the Petitioner is an innocent having no criminal antecedent. The informant has lodged the F.I.R. with false allegation.

5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioner. However, it is directed that in the event the Petitioner surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M.(S), Cuttack in G.R.Case No.1370 of 2022 arising out of Lalbag P.S.Case No.167 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and moves for bail, he shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate.

6. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
