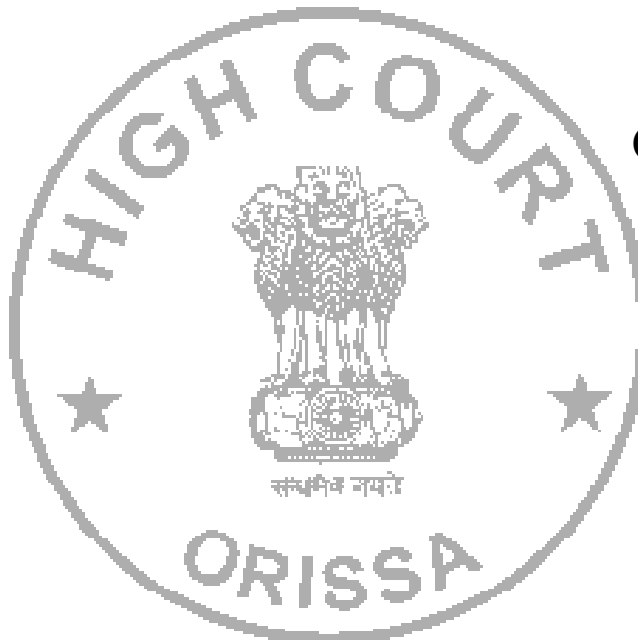

1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
 2. We have shown the statement of the victim girl whose name has been withheld by us for protecting her identity in the public records as recorded by the J.M.F.C. Kujanga under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C. to Mr. G. Muduli, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
 3. In the said statement, the victim has categorically stated that she left the house of the petitioner on 17.06.2022. She was major on that day. She left the house of the petitioner on her own volition and nobody had kidnapped and abducted her. She has further stated that on 20.08.2022 she had married one Biswajit Mallik in the Baba Nanguli Matha and Maa Tarini Temple, Jadupur Kendrapada.
