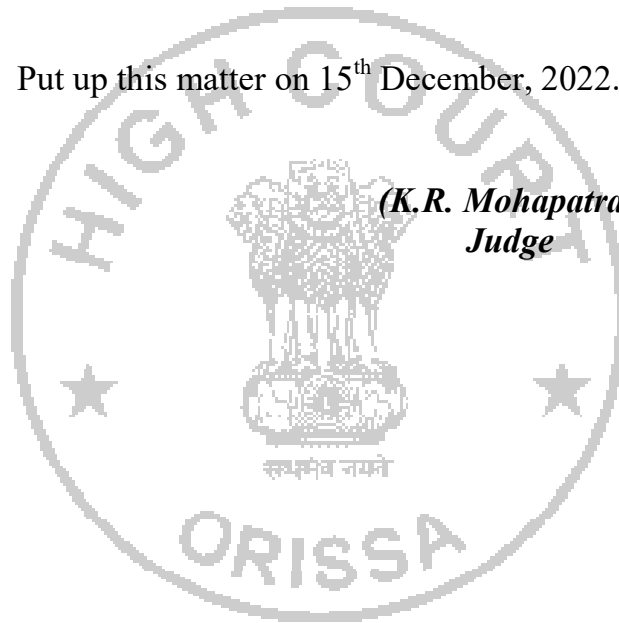
University, Bhawanipatna by the Petitioner and submits that the Petitioner has already vacated the quarters since 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2022.
