1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is an accused in T.R. Case No.32 of 2022 arising out of Jeypore Sadar P.S. Case No.181 of 2022, pending in the Court of the learned Sessions Judge cum Special Judge Koraput, at Jeypore, and offence under Sections 20(b)(ii)(C) of NDPS Act. of the IPC.
4. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned Sessions Judge, Koraput-Jeypore, by order dated 26.07.2022 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.
5. The consideration by the learned Court in seisin over the matter was during the course of investigation.
