1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. 2. Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for the State-Opposite Parties.
3. 3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“(i) The Petitioner, therefore, most respectfully prays that your Lordship may graciously be pleased to admit this writ application and issue rule NISI to the Ops to show cause as to why they shall not be directed to grant financial up-gradation under the RACP scheme taking into account her initial date of appointment as 30.04.86 w.e.f. the date when her juniors were granted such financial up-gradation and release all other service and consequential benefits in her favour to which she is entitled.

And on their failing to show cause or showing insufficient cause the Rule be made absolute.

And further a direction be issued to the Ops to recommend the case of the petitioner for grant of financial up-gradation under the MACP scheme like her juniors”.

4. He further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation on 18.07.2022 at Annexure-2 to the Writ Petition, before the opposite party No.3 but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party No.3 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.3 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
