1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is an accused in Barpali P.S. Case No.188 of 2022 corresponding to C.T. (Spl) Case No.39 of 2022, pending in the Court of learned Sessions Judge -cum- Special Court, Bargarh, under Sections 21(b)/25/29 of the NDPS Act.
4. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned Sessions Judge -cum- Special Court, Bargarh, by order dated 25.07.2022 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.
5. Perused the order of rejection.
6. Admittedly since the seizure of the Eskuf Syrup to the tune of 160 grams is less than the commercial quantity as prescribed, this

Court directs the petitioner to be released on bail on such terms to be fixed by the Court in seisin over the matter.

7. Additionally, it is directed that one of the sureties shall be immediate family member of the accused.

8. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.
