1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is accused in Economic Offence Wing, Bhubaneswar P.S. Case No.05 of 2022 dated 14.03.2022, T.R. No. C.T. 3(C) of 2022 OPID, Balasore, pending in the file of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Special Court, OPID, Balasore, Orissa, for alleged commission of offences under Sections 406/420/467/468/471/120-B of IPC, Section 66 of I.T. Act read with Sections 4,5 & 6 of Prize Chits & Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act, 2011 and Section 6 of OPID Act.
4. Being aggrieved by the Rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned P.O. Designated Court, OPID, Balasore, by order dated 18.06.2022 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.

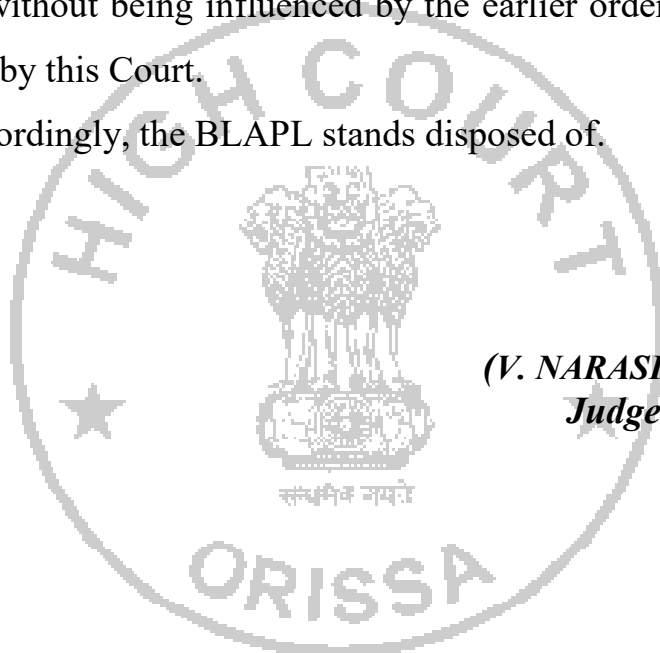
5. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that during pendency of the bail application charge-sheet was filed on 13.09.2022.
