1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
 3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail.
 4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the allegations made in the F.I.R. are totally false and fabricated. Both the Petitioners are brother and sister and Petitioner No.1 is a lady. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that due to previous enmity the informant has lodged the F.I.R. against the Petitioners and there is no criminal antecedent against the present petitioners.
 5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the

offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners. However, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners surrender before the learned S.D.J.M., Panposh, Rourkela in G.R.Case No.1386 of 2022 arising out of Sector-15 P.S.Case No.67 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and move for bail, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate and subject to verification of criminal antecedent of similar nature. It is further directed that the Petitioners while on bail shall not threaten, influence, terrorise the informant and his family members and shall appear before the I.O. as and when required. Violation of condition shall entail cancellation of bail.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
7. Issue urgent certified copy of this order as per Rules.
