1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will make a fresh representation to Sanctioning Authority that is Collector Bargarh, Opposite Party No.2 for sanction and release of the subsistence allowance at the entitled rate.
