On receipt of the same, learned counsel for the State would do well to send the same to the IIC of the concerned Police Station for its due service with necessary information that the matter is likely to be listed for hearing in the week commencing 16th January, 2023; when they can raise their objections in the matter of grant of bail to the Petitioner and further for the purpose if they require the assistance of a legal counsel of their choice, they may approach the nearest Taluk

Legal Services Committee/ District Legal Service Authority to avail that facility/s.

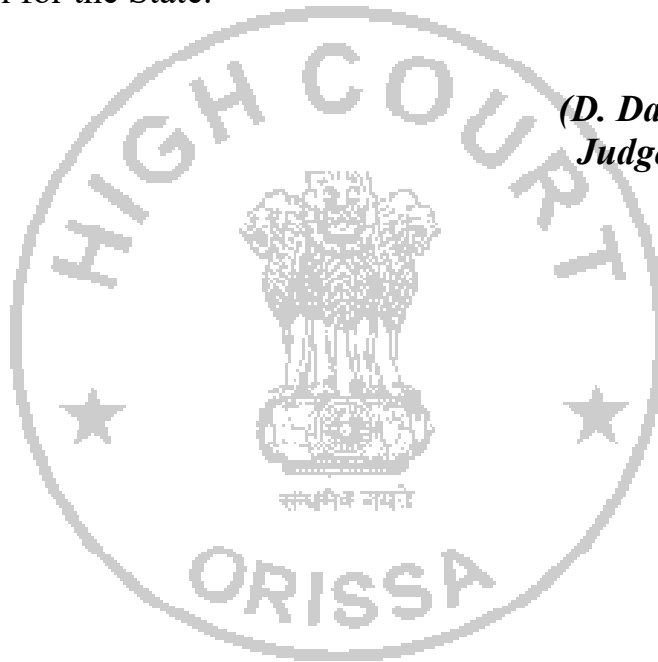
5. Learned counsel for the State is directed to obtain case diary including the statements of the informant & victim for perusal, by the next date of listing.
