1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for the State-Opposite Parties.

3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“(i) Admit this Writ Petition.

(ii) Issue notice and call for the relevant records.

(iii) After hearing issue a Writ of mandamus directing the Opp. Parties to treat the service of the petitioner is under Pensionary benefits thereby disposing the representation of the Petitioner vide Annexure-5.

(iv) Issue any other order / orders, direction / directions, Writ / Writs as this Hon’ble Court deems just and proper”.

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation on 20.12.2021 at Annexure-5 to the Writ Petition, before the opposite party No.1 but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to

opposite party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
