aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.

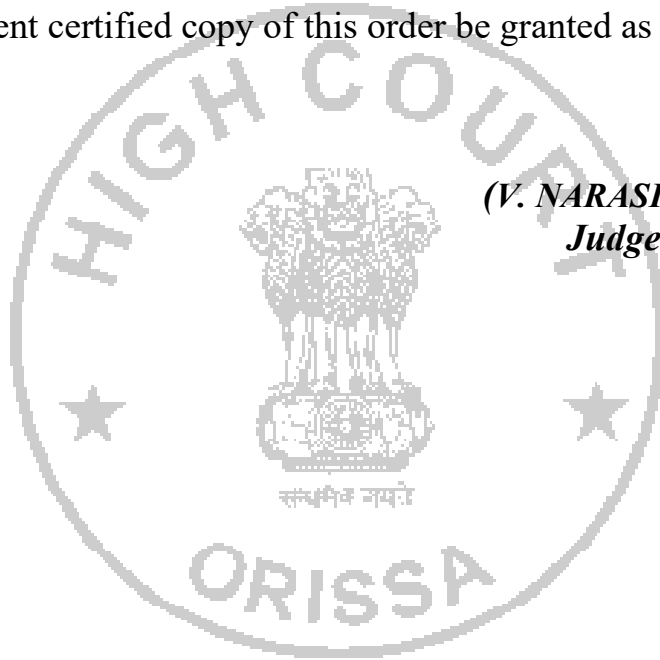
6. Perused the statement of the victim recorded under Section
