This matter is taken up by hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to demarcate the public road and decide the quantum of encroachment by the petitioner within a stipulated time.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before opposite party no.4 vide Annexure-9, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Section 255 (1) of the Orissa Municipal Act, 1950, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

As agreed by learned counsel for the parties, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing opposite party no.4 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner under Annexure-9 taking into consideration Section 255 (1) of the Orissa Municipal Act, 1950, and pass a reasoned and

speaking order as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
