- 1.** **1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard Mr. N.R.Routray, learned counsel for Petitioner and Mr. Mishra, learned Addl. Government Advocate for the State-Opposite Parties.
- 3.** The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“(i) The petitioner humbly prays that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit this writ petition, issue notice to the Opp.Parties to file their show cause and after hearing the opp.parties issue necessary order to treat the petitioner as MBK of Mangalpur GP w.e.f., 29.07.2022 & release the salary;

And further direct the Opp.Party No.2 to take appropriate action against Opp.Party Nos.4, 5, 6 & 7 under the law in not respecting the order dtd. 23.06.2022 passed in Misc. Case No.39/2022 in compliance to order of this Hon’ble Court dtd. 16.12.2021 passed in W.P.(C) No.39367 / 2021”.

- 4.** Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation on 02.08.2022 at Annexure-11-Series to the Writ Petition, before the opposite party No.2 but till

date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
