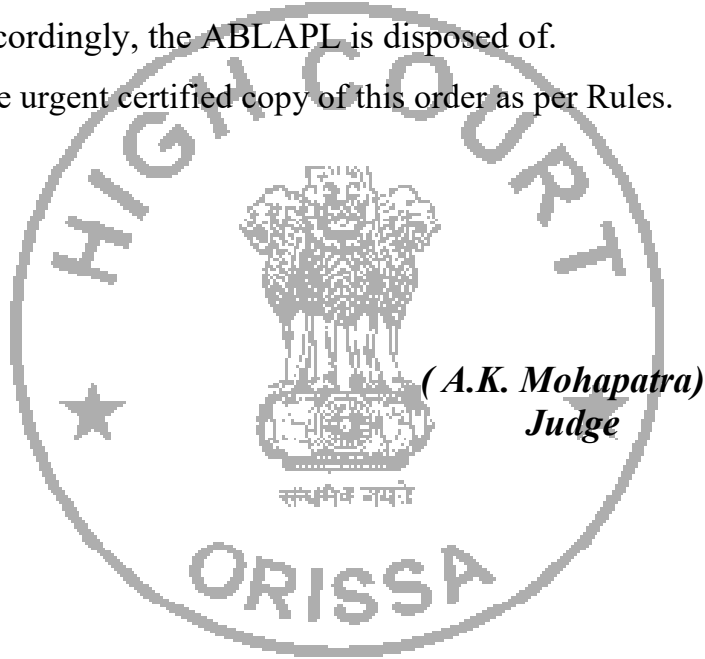

1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
  2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Additional Standing Counsel. Perused the records.
  3. This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail.
  4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the Petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicate out of family dispute between the parties. He also submits that the Petitioners have no criminal antecedents of similar nature.
  5. Considering the nature of allegations made, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners. However, it is directed that in the

event the Petitioners surrender before the learned J.M.F.C., Khallikote in G.R.Case no.945 of 2022 arising out of Rambha P.S.Case No.334 of 2022 within a period of three weeks from today and move for bail, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the learned Magistrate and subject to verification of criminal antecedents of similar nature. It is also directed that the Petitioners while on bail shall cooperate with the investigation and shall appear before the I.O. as and when required. Violation of conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
